2019 FSCC JUNIOR SUMMER CAMP GUIDELINES

REGISTRATION & REFUNDS

Initial

- Registration for the Feather Sound Country Club Junior Summer Camp must be completed at least one week prior to your camp week. Full payment must be submitted with all registration forms in order to reserve your child/children's space(s) in the program. There will be no proration of fees for any days a child participant does not attend camp.

HOURS OF OPERATION / PICKUP PROCEDURES

Initial

- Camp hours are 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM.
- Extended hours are 7:30 AM – 5:00 PM and are available for \$50.00/week.
- Children will only be released to parents, guardians, or individuals listed on the registration form.

MEDICAL NEEDS/ALLERGIES

Initial

- In the event of a medical emergency, FSCC staff will take immediate steps to secure medical treatment while making every effort to contact you.
- Feather Sound Country Club does not administer medication without written permission from the parent or legal guardian. If your child requires medication during camp hours, you must provide prescription (in original container), with name of child, directions, amount of dosage, doctor's name and telephone number.

ILLNESS

Initial

- Feather Sound Country Club cannot provide care for sick children. A child who is sick before camp begins, should be kept home for their wellbeing as well as the other campers.
- If a child has any sign of illness or fever the parent will be called to pick up the child.
- If a child has no over symptoms of illness but displays significant behavioral changes and is clearly uncomfortable, a parent will be called to pick up the child.
- If a parent cannot be reached the staff will call the emergency contact listed on the registration form.

SNACKS/LUNCH

Initial

- Non-members are required to provide a credit card to be kept on file for all camp incidentals (food, drink, etc.)
- Campers have the option to bring their own snack. Snacks should be packed in a lunch box (with child's name) and snack time will be held approximately half way through each scheduled camp program.
- Campers may bring their own lunch or lunch can be purchased through the Club. If you wish to purchase lunch for your child, please fill out the **2019 Camp Lunch Order Form(s)**.

2019 FSCC JUNIOR SUMMER CAMP GUIDELINES

SUNSCREEN /INSECT REPELLENT

Initial

- FSCC does not provide sunscreen/insect repellent. Parents should apply sunscreen/insect repellent on the child before sending them to camp.
- Sunscreen breaks will be taken periodically. Children can apply sunscreen to themselves using their own sunscreen.
- Spray or mist sunscreen and/or insect repellent are recommended.
- Sunscreen and/or insect repellent must be labeled with your child's name and children may not share these items with others.

RAIN

Initial

- Rain or Shine, camp will be held daily. If inclement weather arises, campers will be directed inside for indoor activities.

WHAT TO WEAR

Initial

- Please make sure your child is in cool, comfortable active wear
- Appropriate footwear for tennis/golf is required

WHAT TO BRING

Initial

- Snacks
- 3-4 Beverages (fruit juice and water are preferred)
- Water Bottle (provided by FSCC)
- Sunscreen/Insect Repellent
- Bathing Suit, Towel, Sandals or Flip Flops
- Change of shirt(s), short(s), and sweatband
- Visor or hat

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Initial

- Electronics (cell phones, iPads, tablets, etc.)
- Weapons

2019 FSCC JUNIOR SUMMER CAMP WAIVER

Initial

I/WE (hereinafter referred to as "Releasor") hereby RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE Feather Sound Country Club and all officers, directors, shareholders, employees, representatives, agents, principals and/or assigns, and any other related companies, including but not limited to, any and all successors and assigns of any such individual and/or entity (hereinafter collectively referred to "Releasee"), from any and all liabilities, claims, demands, damages, actions, causes of action, in any matter whatsoever, whether in law or in equity, arising out of or in any way related to any and all losses, damages and/or injuries, including but not limited to, death or disability, that may be sustained by my child/ward, WHETHER CAUSED BY ANY ACT OR OMISSION OR THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEE, or otherwise while participating in, engaging in, or merely being present during any and all athletic and/or camp related activities, including but not limited to, swimming, tennis, golf, or while in or upon the premises of Feather Sound Country Club where such activities, is/are being conducted or will be conducted.

Initial

I/WE acknowledge and agree that Feather Sound Country Club may use photographs of my child/children while engaging in the aforementioned activities in its promotional materials without compensation and I hereby release the club from any and all liability for any violation of any privacy or proprietary rights with respect to the use of such photographs.

Initial

I/WE acknowledge and agree that Feather Sound Country Club will suffer irreparable harm in the event I/WE breach the aforesaid covenants and agreement not to sue and monetary damages would be insufficient to remedy the breach. Accordingly, this covenant not to sue shall be specifically enforceable by the Releasee by injunction against Releasor. In the event Releasee must move to enjoin or dismiss any action filed despite this covenant and agreement not to sue, Releasor will be liable for the attorney's fees and costs incurred in doing so.

Initial

I/WE HEREBY AGREE THAT I HAVE READ THE ABOVE DISCLAIMER AND THAT I/WE AM/ARE THE CHILD'S PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN WITH THE AUTHORITY TO GRANT THIS WAIVER, AND I/WE AGREE TO THE ABOVE TERMS AND CONDITIONS VOLUNTARILY AND WITHOUT RESERVATION.
